Mini data sheet on lettuce necrotic spot nepovirus

Added in 1999 - Deleted in 2002

Reasons for deletion:

Lettuce necrotic spot virus has been included in EPPO Alert List for more than 3 years and during this period no particular international action was requested by the EPPO member countries. In 2002, it was agreed that it could be deleted, considering that sufficient alert has been given.

Lettuce necrotic spot nepovirus (a new virus of lettuce)

Why Lettuce necrotic spot nepovirus came to our attention as it was reported as a

new virus of lettuce in Portugal.

Where In the north of Portugal. On which plants Lettuce (*Lactuca sativa*).

Damage Affected plants showed necrotic spots.

Possible identity A new virus tentatively called Lettuce necrotic spot nepovirus and apparently

related to Arabis mosaic nepovirus.

Pathway Unknown (plants for planting?)

Possible risks Data in general is lacking, and particularly on the severity of the disease.
